Customer Information on the PPWR

Dear Sir or Madam,

Starting August 12, 2026, the new European Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR) will introduce progressively stricter requirements for packaging and the materials used therein.

We are closely monitoring these regulatory changes and are currently working intensively with our upstream suppliers to systematically implement the requirements.

As we have recently received an increasing number of customer inquiries regarding relevant declarations of conformity, we would like to provide you with a brief update on our current progress. We are currently analyzing and evaluating the packaging materials we use based on the new legislation. To provide you with reliable, legally compliant documentation, we rely on input and specific data from our supply chain. We are currently gathering and verifying this information step by step.

Since both we and our suppliers comply with applicable REACH limits, we assume that the requirements regarding substances of concern under Art. 5(1) of the PPWR are generally met. However, we must also point out that, at this stage, we cannot confirm the complete absence of heavy metals or compliance with the cumulative limit value specified in Art. 5(4) of the PPWR. Regarding Art. 5(5) of the PPWR, we also wish to provide transparent information about the composition of our products containing PE foams and polyolefinic liners. These items contain PFAS. We are not currently aware of the presence of PFAS in other products intended for packaging applications.

Once we have received all necessary specifications in full and completed our internal reviews, we will promptly provide you with the required proof of conformity. We thank you for your patience and your cooperative partnership. Your usual contacts remain available to answer any questions you may have.
